



## GENERAL RULES

- 7-a-side per team with optional one extra player for registration.
- 7 overs per inning
- The Game will be played in Baseball diamonds
- MRI Tennis Balls and Stumps will be provided, Cricket bats will not be provided.
- Registration fee is \$70 per team. You can pay it by cash or check payable to Federation of Indian Association
- In case of any disputes between teams/members, umpires decision is final
- The Neutral main umpire can overrule leg umpire, in case of confusion.
- Teams should be available and check at the FIA cricket table for their next game or any question.
- There will be 10-15 minutes gap between games for each team.
- The match winner will be decided on points
- (Winner gets 2 points each, loser gets 0 point for each team. Group winners will go to next round
- (Rounds will be decided based on number of teams available for next round).
- In case of a tie, the run-rate will be used, and then number of wickets lost in the match overall. Other parameters such as wide/noball can also be used, in case of tie under all the above categories as mentioned.
- Tournament Coordinators will communicate only with the team captain, team captain should explain the rules to their team.
- Team captains are expected to co-ordinate, convince and control their team members.
- Each team must provide 2 contact person for communication and also be willing to be neutral umpires in case of need
- Each team must send at least 2 representatives including the **captain to Captain's Meeting on Sunday, August 15 2010.**
- **Registration Form along with registration fee of \$70.00 per team should be received by FIA before Saturday, August 14, 2010.**

## TROPHY AND PRIZES

- The top 2 teams will be awarded.
- The winner will get a Trophy and cash prize of \$300.00
- The runner up team will get a prize of \$150.00
- The prize will be awarded on September 18 2010
- at Veterans memorial during India festival 2010.
- The winner and runner up team will get free tickets for registered team members to the India festival to be present for award ceremony. This is a \$48.00 value

## TEAM ROSTER

- Each team must have at least 7 players plus 1 extra.
- Please have your final team roster sent to Hiren Nagar by Saturday, August 14, 2010.
- **An individual can play in one team only**

## GROUPS AND POLLS

- Each team gets to play at least 3 games within the group.
- Knock out round (sudden death) starts after each team has played their initial 3 games.
- Groups and team numbers will be decided at the Captain's Meeting
- A pre-defined schedule with generic groups and team numbers will be made prior to the tournament.

## WIDE BALL, NO BALL, LBW

- One baller can bowl no more than 3 overs.
- Wicket keeper can bowl.
- No leg before wicket
- No balls and wide balls will be governed by normal cricket rule
- Each no ball and wide will get one extra ball
- Overthrows will have runs if it crosses the declared areas those many runs will be added to the ones already run while the ball was in bound
